Two Ph.D. scholarship are available for Myanmar citizens to pursue their study at Mahidol University under the Mahidol-Norway Capacity Building Initiative for Myanmar Phase 2 scheme. Prospect students under this scholarship must fulfill the selection criteria listed as follows:

1. Background education

Hold a Master's degree in science or engineering in environment or relevant fields with a grade point average (GPA) of at least 3.5

2. English competence standard: All applicants must provide:

- an IELTS score with a minimum of 5.0 or
- a TOEFL Paper-based score with a minimum of 500; or
- a TOEFL Computer-based score with a minimum of 173; or
- a TOEFL Internet-based score with a minimum of 61; or
- a TOEFL-ITP score with a minimum of 500, attained from a test administered by the

Language Center, Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University

3. Concept proposal on the proposed Ph.D. dissertation (2-3 pages)
